- 2. Known as “The Great Commission”**

# “Commission”

(1) Instruction with a command, a duty, given to an individual or a group.

(2) Websters 1828 -

- i) The act of committing or sending to; the act of entrusting, as a charge or duty. Hence,
- ii) The thing committed, entrusted or delivered; letters patent, or any writing from proper authority, given to a person as his warrant for exercising certain powers, or the performance of any duty, whether civil, ecclesiastical, or military. Hence,
- iii) Charge; order; mandate; authority given.

**[Mark 16:14 NKJV]**

**14 Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen.**

Mark 16:11 — And when they heard that He was alive and had been seen by her, they did not believe.

Mark 16:13 — And they went and told it to the rest, but they did not believe them either.

1. Matt 28:18-20

a) Make disciples - everywhere — teaching them to obey Jesus (discipleship).

2. Luke 24:46-47

a) The gospel — people everywhere need to turn to Jesus, \*Luke's account immediately adds "**Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you, but wait in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high.**" Lk.24:49

3. John 20:19-21

a) [Jhn 20:21-22 NKJV] 21 So Jesus said to them again, "**Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you.**" 22 And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "**Receive the Holy Spirit.**

**[Mar 16:16 NKJV] "He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned."**

- A. It's not water that saves, it's the new life given to us in the Holy Spirit — we are baptized into the body of Christ by the Holy Spirit.
- 1. The clearest example that shows the meaning of baptizo is a text from the Greek poet and physician Nicander, who lived about 200 B.C. It is a recipe for making pickles and is helpful because it uses both words. Nicander says that in order to make a pickle, the vegetable should first be 'dipped' (baptô) into boiling water and then 'baptised' (baptizô) in the vinegar solution. Both verbs concern the immersing of vegetables in a solution. But the first is temporary. The second, the act of baptising the vegetable, produces a permanent change.*
