Jesus' agony in 6 expressions

1. troubled / utterly surprised
2. deeply distressed / sore troubled (heaviness)
3. My soul is exceedingly sorrowful (pressed / engulfed)
4. even unto death (physical in danger)
5. being in agony (Lk 22:44a / conflict)
6. sweat became as it were great drops of blood (Lk 22:44b / hematohidrosis)

[Mar 14:33-34](#) And He took Peter, James, and John with Him, and He began to be troubled and deeply distressed. Then He said to them, "My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here and watch."

[Luke 22:44](#) "And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground."
