Hello friends & family,

I would just like to start off by saying how grateful we are for each one of you. We are so grateful for how the Lord has brought the body of Christ together, building one another up in all that we do, all for His glory and His glory alone!

This spring has been quite busy to say the least, we have been travelling to the Ehattesaht First Nation Reserve every week doing home visits, one-on-one Bible studies and discipleship. We have been seeing God work in the lives of the people we are doing Bible studies with. It has been so awesome to see how the Holy Spirit and God's Word can penetrate someone's heart and speak to each individual so personally. His Holy Spirit has been guiding these studies so well, it gets us so excited with each Bible study! Praise God for His faithfulness in not only our lives, but also the people around us who are choosing to follow and be transformed by Him. In Ezekiel 34:11-12 the verse says, "'For thus says the Lord GOD: "Indeed I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out. As a shepherd seeks out his flock on the day he is among his scattered sheep, so will I seek out My sheep and deliver them from all the places where they were scattered on a cloudy and dark day."' This Word is so powerful - the fact that it is God alone who searches for His sheep and God alone who brings restoration. He just calls us to be obedient to Him and His Holy Spirit does the rest.

At the end of April we began our 3 weeks of NCEM Candidate Training. It was such an incredible time of learning and growing. Discipleship has been a huge passion and calling of ours and we are so excited, to say the least, to be a part of the work the Lord is going to do in this six week program.
